# <sup>1</sup>UK Legislation

The term 'UK Legislation' refers to "The International Tax Compliance Regulations 2015" created to enable automatic exchange of financial account information under four different regimes: 1. The United States Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act - FATCA, 2. the Crown Dependencies and Gibraltar Regulations - CDOT, 3. The Common Reporting Standard developed by the OECD - CRS, 4. The EU Directive on Administrative Cooperation in Tax Matters - DAC.

# <sup>2</sup>Tax Identification Number (TIN)

The term "TIN" means Taxpayer Identification Number or a functional equivalent in the absence of a TIN. A TIN is a unique combination of letters or numbers assigned by a jurisdiction to an individual or an Entity and used to identify the individual or Entity for the purposes of administering the tax laws of such jurisdiction. Some jurisdictions do not issue a TIN. However, these jurisdictions often utilise some other high integrity number with an equivalent level of identification (a "functional equivalent"). Examples of that type of number include, for individuals, a social security/insurance number, citizen/personal identification/service code/number, and resident registration number. For UK tax residents a TIN can be either a National Insurance Number or a UTR.
